Appeal of Fresno, California Field Office Decision

Form N-600, Application for a Certificate of Citizenship

The Applicant, who was born abroad in 2008 to married parents, seeks a Certificate of Citizenship to reflect that he derived U.S. citizenship through his U.S. citizen father under section 320 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (the Act), 8 U.S.C. § 1420.

The Director of the Fresno, California Field Office denied the Form N-600, concluding that the Applicant was not eligible for a Certificate of Citizenship because he did not respond to a request for evidence requiring he submit two passport style photographs and documentation of residence in the United States. On appeal, the Applicant submits the requested documentation including two passport style photographs and school records from an elementary school in California showing enrollment from 2013 to the present, as well as residence with both parents in the United States during this time.

Because the Applicant appears to have now satisfied the request for evidence by submitting these documents, we will remand the matter for the Director to make a determination of whether the Applicant meets all of the eligibility criteria for a Certificate of Citizenship under section 320 of the Act.

**ORDER:** The decision of the Director is withdrawn. The matter is remanded for the entry of a new decision consistent with the foregoing analysis.
